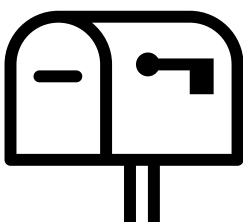
FSFSA Application

- Complete & Submit Your 2021/22 FAFSA Form/Application



- Visit FSFSA.gov on a computer/tablet
- Follow Prompts to Complete & Submit Your 2021/22 FAFSA Form/



- By mail. Visit StudentAid.gov/Resources
 - Download the pdf version of the 2021/22 FSFSA Form/Application or Call 1-800-433-3243 to request printed form
 - Complete & Return By Mail for Processing
- Warning: This option will take the longest amount of time!***

Common MISTAKES

Remember to:

- Create a Username & Password (FSA ID) *before* starting the FAFSA Form/Application
- Use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool
- Report ALL Required Information
- Sign Your FAFSA Form/Application



ORDER IN WHICH YOU

Accept Financial Aid:

1. Scholarships & Grants
2. Federal Work-Study
3. Loans

After SUBMITTING

- Complete & review your financial aid offers from the school(s) that have accepted you. Inform your chosen school what you will be accepting.
- Complete entrance counseling & sign a Master Promissory Note (MPN) if you have accepted federal student loans.
- Receive your financial aid funds; which will be disbursed by your school.
